

# How to Read your JBHS Graduation Status Report

## What do all of these numbers mean?

- A typical student will take 60 credits each year.
- 5 credits = 1 semester class
- 10 credits = 1 year-long class

## Subject areas

- Once a subject area is completed, any additional classes will move into the "Electives" subject area.
- A foreign language is NOT required for graduation. However, colleges require at least 2 years of the same language.
- The practical art requirement can be completed by taking the 3<sup>rd</sup> year of a foreign language (same language).
- Practical arts classes are hands-on and/or career-based skill building classes.
- Fine arts classes are classes in the visual and performing arts.
