Dear Disney Parents and the Community,

Due to the Holidays I have incorporated the last two weeks in this update.

I am very pleased to announce that after having received the DSA approval, we have begun the bidding process. We are using a service called Quality Bidders to prequalify Companies that are interested in bidding on the Disney Project. This is done to ensure that the bidders have the ability to obtain Bonding and have the ability to complete the work that is bid on.

The District and Lundgren Management have the planning and bidding process underway with the first bid publication going out on December 19th. This is very exciting news!

The first stages of the work will be clearing the playground of obstacles such as trees, poles, basketball poles, the ball wall, garden and play equipment. This work is scheduled to start happening the second and third weeks of January 2021 followed by excavation, compaction and the foundation work. The first pre-bid conference was held this week virtually on January 5th 2021 to kick off the project followed by site job walks by appointment only.
