On Tuesday, September 17<sup>th</sup>, we will begin our Response to Intervention (RTI program) for the 2019-2020 school year at Stevenson. RTI is a means to expand our school's capacity to reach and support diverse learners. The RTI framework emphasizes intervention and progress monitoring through effective instruction and assessment. By utilizing the RTI program, teachers are able to address all students' unique learning needs with small group instruction.

This year Stevenson is fortunate to have three credentialed intervention teachers who will be working with students for ELA and math intervention. Our intervention teachers are Mrs. Gibson, Mrs. Bowne, and Mr. Spence. The intervention teachers push-in to classrooms during small group instruction, Tuesday-Friday, for ELA and math in each class.

During RTI your child will be working on these skills to increase their confidence and progress in reading and/or math. The groups are fluid, so if they show strong growth in specific skills they may not receive the additional support from the intervention teacher for the entire semester.
