Senior Portraits:

All Seniors must have their Senior Portraits taken by the first day of school – August 12, 2024 to appear in the yearbook. Seniors should have been contacted by White's Studios during the summer to schedule an appointment to have Senior Portraits taken. Cap and Gowns / Class Rings / Graduation Announcements:

In September, Jostens will be providing Seniors with all the details for ordering. Jostens will then be back on campus (date to be determined) for students to order senior merchandise. All Seniors must order their caps and gowns to participate in our graduation ceremony. Class rings, graduation announcements and other senior merchandise is optional. Lunch Passes:

All Seniors MUST BE PRE-APPROVED to receive a lunch pass to leave campus during lunch. Lunch passes are a privilege and may be revoked at the discretion of the JBHS administration – due to grades, attendance, tardies, indebts, off-grads, etc. Parents can revoke lunch passes at any time. **Lunch pass applications are available on the JBHS website under the Student Services Office tab.**

Lunch Pass Criteria:

- Must be an 11th or 12th Grade student
- Must have a 2.0 GPA
- Must not have excessive absences or tardies
- No F's in any class
- No U's in Citizenship
- No Disciplinary Issues/Suspensions

Parking Permits:

Students are required to obtain a Parking Permit in order to park in the student parking lot. Parking permits are issued per semester. Grades, absences, tardies, and discipline will be checked. Students will need to RE-APPLY for a parking permit for the Spring Semester. The student parking lot will be open for anyone for the first two weeks of school. Permits will be assigned and begin at the third week of school. **Parking Permit applications are available on the JBHS website under the Student Services Office tab.**

Parking Pass Eligibilities:

- Must be an 11th or 12th Grade student
- Must have a 3.0 GPA
- No F's in any class
- No U's in Citizenship
- Not on a Tardy Contract
- No Disciplinary Issues/Suspensions

Senior Packet and Senior Calendar:

In February 2025, the Senior Packet will be made available ONLINE to all Seniors. This packet will include detailed information regarding all the end of the year activities (e.g. Senior Prom, Cap & Gown distribution, Graduation Tickets, Senior Slideshow, Senior Brunch, Gold Tassels, Academic Achievement Pins, etc.) The packet will also include a Senior Calendar listing all of the Senior events, ticket sales, diploma pick up and Senior deadlines.

Senior Activities: These end-of-the-school-year celebrations will be an opportunity for Seniors to get together and celebrate their achievements with their friends. It will also allow them to pick up their graduation tickets, cap and gowns, prom photos, achievement certificates, and rehearse for the big day. Information on all these activities will be in the Senior Packet.

Indebts: Any students that owe money or books to the school, must clear these indebts before purchasing tickets for events including school dances, etc.

No Checks Accepted:

AFTER MARCH 14th, for the remainder of the school year. Payments can be made in **cash or credit card** at the Student Store.

Graduation Ceremony Participation Criteria:

Seniors and parents, please READ and SIGN the High School Graduation Ceremony Participation Criteria that can be found in the parent portal. This form will explain all of the requirements in order to participate in the graduation ceremony. This includes academic requirements and attendance. You must complete this form to participate in Graduation. This form must be read and acknowledged by both student and parent as part of the Data Confirmation Process for Senior registration.

Graduation Ceremony:

The Commencement Ceremony for the Class of 2025 will take place on **Friday, May 23, 2025**. The location of this ceremony will be held at Memorial Field. There will be very limited seating for this event. Each graduating Senior will be entitled to **eight (8) free tickets** for family and/or guests to watch the ceremony. More information will be provided in the Spring Semester when the Senior Packet becomes available.

Graduation Ticket Distribution: Graduation tickets will be distributed to Seniors cleared to graduate during the Senior Brunch. Any seniors that do not pick up tickets may pick them up the following day from the Athletics & Activities counter in the Main Office. No additional tickets will be offered for sale nor will any be raffled off.
