Welcome to the 2021-2022 school year! We are excited to have you all back on campus. Enclosed you will find important information about registration. Here are some key points to remember:

Students **must be** present to register on their appropriate registration day. NO PARENT MAY REGISTER WITHOUT THEIR STUDENT BEING PRESENT. If your student cannot make it to registration or attend the makeup day, they must report on Monday, August 16th at 7:00 am with all forms properly filled out and any money needed to complete registration in hand. After completing registration paperwork, all 11th and 12th graders will stay to complete welcome back activities, which will take between 2 and 3 hours from start to finish. All 9th and 10th graders will stay to complete orientation which will take around 2 hours.

9th/10th Parent Orientation: A presentation for parents of incoming 9th and 10th graders that reviews key aspects for success at BHS and the registration process that their student will be participating in during registration. While the focus is on 9th and 10th graders, all families new to BHS are welcome.

- Students will not be allowed to register unless they bring signed and completed forms.
- We will have a lab available for those who have trouble with the online process, however, space is limited. Families are strongly encouraged to have their paperwork complete before arriving.
- Parents are not required to attend the registration process.
- Additional items can be purchased on the day of registration. Cashier's check, money orders, credit cards and cash are accepted. No personal checks will be accepted.
- The library will be open to issue textbooks during registration days and to pay textbook or library book balances. Students are advised to bring a backpack to carry all their books and belongings.
- At the end of registration, students will receive an unofficial schedule. At that time, they may make an appointment to see their counselor if they have an incomplete schedule or they require necessary schedule changes (based on completed summer school course work).
- No schedule changes will be made for period or teacher preferences.
- Makeup days for registration are August 12th and 13th from 8:30-12:00pm. There will not be orientation or welcome back activities on these days.
- On the first day of school, Monday, August 16th at 7:30am, there will be signs posted directing students to their first period. Schedules will be distributed in the first period class. The schedule can also be found on Aeries.
