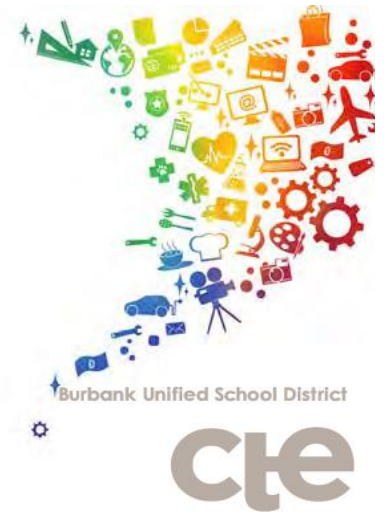


# CTE DUAL ENROLLMENT FALL 2024
