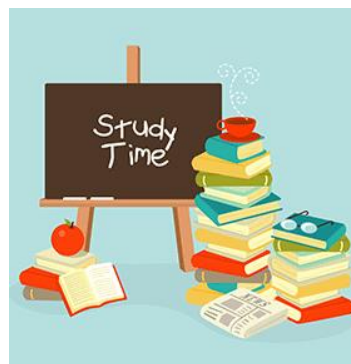
NACAC National College Fairs – Performing and Visual Arts
