## Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the CA Dream Act App Opens October 1<sup>st</sup>

SENIORS! The Free Application for Federal Student Aid also known as FAFSA and the California Dream Act



Application is now open! FAFSA and CADAA are completely free and it is the only way to know if you will qualify for any type of financial aid.

Remember that everyone is eligible for some type of financial aid but you must complete your application by


