CLASS TITLE: PAINTER

BASIC FUNCTION:

Under the direction of the Trades Supervisor, perform skilled work in the surface preparation, painting, marking, and stenciling/signing of District buildings and facilities.

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:

Prepare a variety of surfaces for painting wood, metal, glass, plaster, stucco, wall board, brick and cement; scrape, sand and file as necessary.

Mix paints and stains to match existing colors and finishes.

Estimate materials and approximate time required for painting activities under the direction of the Trades Supervisor.

Use brush, roller or spray gun to apply a variety of surface coverings such as paint, varnish, shellac, enamel, lacquer or other protective or decorative finishes.

Operate water blaster to remove graffiti and prepare surfaces for painting.

Apply undercoats and finish coats as necessary.

Perform work necessary for furniture refinishing.

Erect, move and work on ladders and scaffolding.

Clean and maintain brushes, tools and other equipment as required.

Perform periodic inspections of painted surfaces to determine need for painting.

Maintain and secure materials related to position.

Maintain records to meet Environmental Protection Agency requirements related to position.

Coordinate activities with other maintenance personnel as necessary.

Perform related duties as assigned.

KNOWLEDGE AND ABILITIES:

KNOWLEDGE OF:

Methods of preparing a variety of surfaces for painting and finish work.
Standard practices, methods, materials and equipment used in painting and finish work.
Health and safety procedures and practices involved in painting assignments.
Technical aspects of field of specialty.
Proper methods of storing equipment, materials and supplies.

ABILITY TO:

Perform skilled work in painting and finish work.
Prepare a variety of surfaces for painting or other surface coverings.
Erect and work from ladders and scaffolding.
Estimate materials and approximate time required for painting work.
Understand and apply painting trade safety standards and procedures.
Understand and follow oral and written directions.
Determine paint requirements and surfaces.
Work cooperative and effectively with others.
Use a variety of tools and machines utilized in the basic trade.
Observe legal and defensive driving practices.
Lift objects weighing up to 50 pounds using safe and proper methods and/or equipment; move objects weighing over 50 pounds using safe and proper methods and/or equipment.
Complete assignments in an efficient and timely manner.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

Any combination equivalent to: sufficient training and experience to demonstrate journey-level skill in the painting trade.

LICENSES AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

Valid California driver's license.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

Work includes indoor and outdoor environment; subject to lifting, climbing, working on scaffolding and ladders and exposure to paint fumes.
