CLASS TITLE: PLASTERER AND CEMENT FINISHER

BASIC FUNCTION:

Under the direction of the Trades Supervisor, perform skilled plaster and cement work to maintain and repair interior and exterior surfaces and facilities.

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:

Prepare both interior and exterior surfaces for plaster or ceramic tile.

Mix and apply plaster including base, brown and finish coats as required.

Excavate and make subgrades for cement; build and install forms for sidewalks, slabs and curbs; pour and finish cement.

Cut, fit and install ceramic tile.

Install and repair fences including gates, pipes and posts; perform related concrete work.

Erect, move and work on scaffolds and ladders as necessary.

Assist in preparing for special events and activities as required; install and remove goal posts for athletic events.

Maintain routine records, such as records of materials used, as required.

Operate a variety of equipment and machines including truck, tractors, cement mixers, jack hammers, roto hammers, levels, saws and other hand and power tools.

Welding as needed for benches, gates, fences and miscellaneous requests as needs arise.

Sheet metal fabrication for roof vents, and gutter and drain repairs.

Carpet and linoleum flooring replace and repair.

Clearing and cleaning gutters during harsher weather conditions.

Perform related duties as assigned.

KNOWLEDGE AND ABILITIES:

KNOWLEDGE OF:

Methods, equipment and materials used in plaster and cement work.

Proper methods and techniques used in cutting, fitting and installing ceramic tile.

Proper methods of storing equipment, materials and supplies; appropriate health and safety practices and procedures.

Basic record-keeping techniques.

ABILITY TO:

Weld to fix district equipment

Sheet metal fabrication for repairs

Replace and repair carpet and linoleum flooring

Climbing to clear and clean gutters

Perform skilled plaster cement work.

Build and install forms for sidewalks, slabs and curbs.

Cut, fit and install ceramic tiles.

Install and repair fences.

Erect, move and work on scaffolds and ladders.

Determine plaster and cement repair needs.

Operate a variety of equipment and machines including trucks, tractors, cement mixers, jack hammers, roto hammers, saws and other hand and power tools.

Maintain routine records.

Work from blue prints, shop drawings and sketches.

Understand and follow oral and written directions.

Lift objects weighing up to 80 pounds using safe and proper methods and/or equipment.

Move objects over 80 pounds using safe and proper methods and/or equipment.

Perform heavy manual labor.

Observe legal and defensive driving practices.

Work cooperatively and effectively with others.

Complete assignments in an efficient and timely manner.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

Any combination equivalent to: sufficient training and experience to demonstrate journey-level skill in the plastering and cement finishing trade.

LICENSES AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

Valid California driver's license.

WORKING CONDITIONS

Indoor and outdoor environment; subject to lifting and climbing and exposure to dust, fumes and noise.
