DUAL IMMERSION SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM

We are planning to offer a summer school program for Dual Immersion students this year. Subjects taught will be Spanish Language Arts, Spanish Language Development, and Math. The program for incoming students entering grades K-5 will be at William McKinley Elementary School. Classes will be taught in Spanish following a 90/10 model.

If selected, you will be informed, via your district email, of your assignment.

There will be a mandatory pre-school meeting on Friday, May 8, 2020 from 3:30 – 4:30 p.m.

All necessary information will be covered for your first workday.

QUALIFICATIONS AND SELECTION PROCEDURE

The following will be considered in recommending teachers for the Dual Immersion summer school teaching positions:

First choice will be given to teachers who are regular employees of the Burbank Unified School District.

Recency of summer school teaching shall be considered.

Basis for election will be the following:

- (1) Specific training and/or experience for the particular assignment.
- (2) The possession of a teaching credential covering the subject area to be taught.
- (3) Evidence of successful experience in teaching the subject matter or course offered during the summer.
