



Grade Improvement/Non-BUSD Summer 2022 Course Options

Non-BUSD Courses

If you are interested in taking a **non BUSD course** at a community college, charter high school, or fee-based school please take a look at our petition process video [here](#).

*Some classes that are not offered in our BUSD summer school program such as initial credit math and foreign language can be found in these programs. Students may only take up to 10 credits (2 semesters worth of initial credit) of classes. You must sign up for **BOTH** semesters of the class. Note that all of the high school options are asynchronous and self-paced.*

In order to receive BHS credit for a course, you must do the following:

1. **Submit [a petition](#) for approval** by the district (this is not guaranteed - your counselor will notify you regarding the status of your petition after it has been processed)
2. **Share your transcript** from your summer school program with BHS upon completion of your course (this process will differ depending on the program you use).

Some **schools to check out** to see if they fit your summer plans include the following:

High School:

- [Opportunities for Learning](#) (free)
 - Note that math is only a credit recovery option, so students looking for initial credit math should look elsewhere.
 - Students should email their counselor the recommendation form for signature after fully completing it with a parent/guardian
 - Includes up to Spanish 3
 - Dates: 7/1 - 8/4



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- [Options For Youth](#) (free)
 - Includes up to Spanish 2, math up to Pre-Calculus offered
 - Dates: 6/27-8/4
- [Ivy Tech](#) (free)
 - Math and Spanish classes (some Spanish classes are waitlisted/closed)
 - Dates: 7/1 - 8/5
- [Silicon Valley High School](#) (\$)
 - Most affordable option for Pre-Calculus that is available all summer
 - Dates: open-ended – must complete before 8/12
- [UC Scout](#) (\$)
 - Dates: open-ended - must complete before 8/12
- [BYU Independent Study](#) (\$)
 - Dates: open-ended - must complete before 8/12
- [La Canada Educational Foundation](#) (\$)
 - Dates: 6/16 – 7/15

Community College:

Note: Please do not petition for world language and/or math classes if you are planning to continue with related BHS classes afterward (e.g., Elementary Spanish at PCC and then Spanish 2 at BHS would not work), as they do not line up with our BUSD curriculum.
