Budget Update

The Legislature is still negotiating the [budget proposal](https://a19.asmdc.org/press-releases/20200603-senate-assembly--agreement-2020-21-budget) with the Governor (read more here: <https://a19.asmdc.org/press-releases/20200603-senate-assembly--agreement-2020-21-budget>). We need to continue our advocacy and email the Governor and the legislature. Tell the Governor to adopt the Legislature's plan [Click here to email your legislators](#). Without the support of the Governor and legislature, **BUSD will be forced to adopt the Governor's May Revise which means \$13 million in budget reductions.
