February Resolution to the Board of Education on Dating Violence Awareness

1. Sally updated the committee on school safety. All schools have buzzers and all but two have cameras. BPD is working with ASB students at Burbank and Burroughs HS to train for active threat. BFD spoke to students a CDS regarding medical emergencies.

Muir Middle School scheduled several days of active threat drills so students would be prepared no matter where they were on campus.

Johanna explained the new Cisco digital phones-when one dials 911 the phone display exactly what location the call is coming from. Also equipped with reverse 911 and PA system.

The Emergency Communication Task Force and the communications committee is continuing to look at a variety of mechanisms to improve communications throughout the district.

2. Active Threat Trainings continue for staff in the district.

A Bullying Awareness and Reporting Training is available in online modules and in person trainings. All staff a required to take this training.

A group representing Burbank USD went to a Trauma and Resiliency training covering the 6 principles of trauma and relsiliency: Safety, Stability, Nuture, Connection, Empowerment, and Support. They stressed the importance of a multi-tiered system of support.
