Parcel Tax Exemption Application Form
For Senior Citizen Exemption**

To qualify for the Senior Exemption from Parcel Tax, you must: 1) turn 65 years old before July 1 of the application year; 2) own and occupy your property as your principal residence; and 3) apply for the exemption in person at the BUSD Business Office at 1900 W. Olive Ave., Burbank CA 91506, no later than June 30, 2020. Once your exemption request is approved, and unless circumstances change, no future applications are required.
