



Advanced Placement (AP) Exam Info for 2019-20

This year, the College Board made important changes to the AP exam process. Here's what JBHS families need to know:

- Students enrolled in an AP course must sign up for a College Board online account, join their AP class(es), and select the exam(s) they will be taking at **myap.collegeboard.org**. This process should be completed by **September 20, 2019**.
- Exams must be purchased in the **fall** this year. You can purchase exams online through the JBHS WebStore or at the Student Store beginning on **Monday, October 14, 2019**. The price is **\$94** per exam.
- The deadline to purchase AP exams will be **Wednesday, November 13, 2019**. Exams purchased after this date will incur a late fee of **\$40** per exam.
- After **November 13, 2019**, a \$40 cancellation fee (per exam) will be charged to students who purchased an exam, but decide not to take the exam.
- Spring Semester Exception: Only students enrolled in a second semester AP Economics **or** AP Government class will be eligible to purchase that class exam at a later date. The spring sales window will be open from **March 3 - March 12, 2020** for these students.

- To qualify for a fee reduction for the AP exams, please provide documentation that you have been approved for the free and reduced lunch program for the current school year to Ms. Wade in the main office.
